

## Home Group Questions - July 29, 2018

1. Who is the most encouraging person you've ever known? In what way were they encouraging?
2. What is the most encouraging thing anyone has ever said to you?
3. Would you say that you are good or bad at encouraging others? Does it come naturally to you?
4. Read Hebrews 3:12-14 with your group.
  - How does encouragement relate to "sin's deceitfulness"?
  - How does encouragement relate to having a "sinful, unbelieving heart that turns away from the living God"?
5. Read Hebrews 10:19-25.
  - According to this passage, why should we encourage one another?
  - Try to summarize these verses in one or two sentences.
6. We see from these passages that one of the major reasons Christians should encourage one another is because we all "share in Christ" a great victory over sin, and we "have confidence to enter the Most Holy Place by the blood of Jesus". In other words, we can all be encouraged by what Christ has done for us, and sometimes we need to be reminded of that.
  - How can we encourage one another with reminders of what Christ has done for us?
7. What is one thing you can start doing to be more intentional about encouraging others?
8. Go around your group in a circle, with each person sharing one encouraging thing about the person to their left.
